Projects ranged from small single office buildings, through to major mixed use projects of over 1million sq. ft.

David's activities at Stanhope have primarily been in relation to the identification, acquisition and funding of new projects and latterly in leading the strategy of the company.

David is currently a member of the Supervisory Board of the Schroder Exempt Property Unit Trust, a member of the City Property Association and involved in various British Property Federation working groups.
